

HOW TO RESTORE, PROTECT & DECORATE METAL SURFACES

WHAT WILL YOU NEED?

- White Knight Rust Guard SLS Etch Primer
- White Knight Rust Guard Metal Primer
- White Knight Rust Guard Quick Dry Advanced Enamel in Crisp White and Sussex
- Spray gun, roller or brush
- Medium grit sandpaper and wire brush
- Drop sheets and painters tape
- Dust mask and clean rags
- Stirrer

STEP 1

Start by taping up the areas you don't want painted and cover the floor with drop sheets.

STEP 2

To achieve a quality finish prep is key. Give the surface a light sand and a good clean thereafter.

STEP 3

Next we are going to prime the exterior of the caravan with Rust Guard SLS Etch Primer which helps seal the surface. Both the primer and topcoat can be applied using a roller, brush or spray gun. We will be using a spray gun for a fast and seamless finish.

STEP 4

Thereafter, moving on to the chassis. Considering the age of the caravan the chassis is in pretty good shape. All we need to do is remove any loose rust or paint with a wire brush.

STEP 5

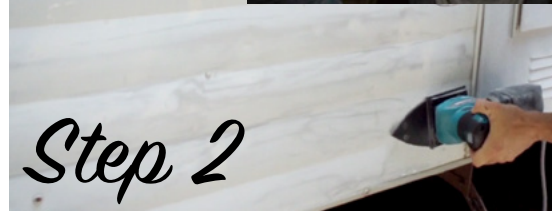
Prime the surface with Rust Guard Metal Primer, which is a hard wearing anti-corrosive primer.

STEP 6

2 hours after applying the primers on to the exterior surface and chassis, you are ready to apply the topcoat. Rust Guard Quick Dry Advanced Enamel is a water based paint that renews rusted surfaces and protects new metal. It dries in 2 hours and can be tinted to 1000s of colours. We have selected 2 colours for Vonnie. Crisp white at the top and Sussex, which is a muted green down the bottom.

The first coat will be touch dry in 30 mins and ready for a re-coat in 2 hours.

Just like that Rust Guard has transformed old Vonnie into a beautiful, trendy vintage caravan.

Give the paint a good stir before you start.
